

## USWCA Airport to Hotel Transportation – For Fall 2019 USWCA Meeting

### **Link Light Rail from SEA TAC Airport to Pioneer Square Station**

Walk across the sky bridge towards the parking garage. Turn left and follow signs to Linked Light Rail Station. Should you need assistance getting to the station there is one courtesy shuttle that can hold up to 5 people with luggage after you cross the sky bridge.

Follow the signs to Light Rail Station, it about ½ mile, so pack light. Once you get to the station area, there are kiosk/pay stations to purchase tickets. The **fare is \$3** for one way, you are **buying a ticket for North Bound University of Washington Train, getting off at Pioneer Square Station**. The kiosk takes cash or credit cards. You should take your ticket with you in case the transit people ask to see your ticket.

Once you have your ticket, go up either the escalator or the elevator and wait for the train. Look for the signs for the northbound train. Get on the train with your luggage and find a seat. **Get off at the Pioneer Square Station**. The ride takes about 40 minutes.

Once you arrive at the Pioneer Square Station, you exit the train on the right side. Turn left out of the train door and proceed towards the escalator that goes to 3<sup>rd</sup> and James. Once at the top of the escalator turn left, there is a large area, cross diagonally to your right to escalator, the overhead sign says 3<sup>rd</sup> and James St. Take this escalator to the top and turn left to get to the sidewalk, James St., turn right immediately and walk ½ block down the hill to 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave., turn right on 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave. and walk about ½ block to the green awning. This is the entrance to the hotel: **Courtyard by Marriott – Pioneer Square**.

Registration for USWCA Meeting is on the 14<sup>th</sup> Floor in the Foyer of the Alaska Club Ballroom, beginning at 11 am on Friday. Safe travels and see you soon.

**For the return trip**, go back to Pioneer Square Light Rail Station, buy ticket (\$3), and catch the southbound train to Angel Lake Station and **get off at the SEA TAC Airport Station**. Go down one level and walk across the bridge to the airport. Safe travels.
