Hotel: The Double Tree RDU/RTP, Durham, NC. Rate is \$124.00 per night, with 2 breakfast tickets per room per night. For complimentary transportation to the hotel from RDU International Airport, call the hotel desk at **919.941.6000** after you have all your bags. The hotel has a full bar in the lobby area, as well as a restaurant.

Renting a car? Major rental companies are available at RDU. The hotel does not charge you to park a car.

Are you driving to Durham? The Double Tree is just off Interstate 40, Miami Boulevard exit, on Page Creek Road. It is about 5.5 miles from the Triangle Curling Center.

President's Dinner on 2/12/18 is at the hotel, a change from past meetings. It is a delicious buffet with a cash bar. No rushing back for those 8:30 pm meetings!

Dutch Treat lunch on Tuesday, 2/13/18, for those who do not have noon meetings, is at Trali Irish Pub and Restaurant in the Brier Creek area of Raleigh. Sign up for a ride at the registration desk. **Dinner on Tuesday night** is at Mez, an upscale contemporary Mexican restaurant. This meal is a fajita bar buffet, with plenty of choices. **Cash or credit cards can be used for your bar drinks at this meal.** Mez is within walking distance from the hotel, but we will have a sign-up sheet at registration for those who do not want to walk over. Both these restaurants are favorites of Lea Franklin, our Triangle Bonspiel chair, and my husband and I have done our research, as well!

If you are staying through Thursday, the Banquet will have a cash bar. This is a buffet with great choices.

At the Triangle Curling Center, our bar has beer and wine licenses. The bar is credit card only—no cash—and you can run a tab for a day, if you wish. **No outside alcohol is allowed in both the building and the parking lot.** Thank you for helping us protect our licenses!
