Procedure Report: There are 32 teams entered for the bonspiel. 29 club teams and 3 composite teams. The composite teams were made up from singles from areas. Reps please encourage singles to sign up with the initial good faith entry. If clubs do not have enough members to complete a team, please sign up as singles- there is no fee involved just a commitment to be able to curl. At the Nov 30 deadline there were 30 club teams- 2 teams dropped out prior to the Dec 18th final payment. One club team from St. Paul came forward immediately Dec 2nd. Then the composite teams were pulled together. One from West I/II, one Central, and one West I/West II, Wisc. Calls went out to the area coordinators for additional players and subs.
