

Rules Committee Report  
February 8, 2011

The Rules Committee met at 11:00 AM on February 8, 2011 in the Cuyahoga Room. In attendance from the committee: Candice Clark, Lorrie Michael, Gloria Martino, Kelly Stephens, and chair Carol Stevenson. Carol Wood and Star Pfiffner were also in attendance.

The committee will be sending forth wording that speaks to the Rules & Regulations governing The USWCA Women's Circuit Event and information (as it is provided to us) from the Five and Under Challenge. Our goal is to have all of this language added to the body of the USWCA Rules & Regulations after this meeting. Look for the updated rules before the fall meetings on the website.

Discussion took place regarding inquiries made to the committee concerning coaching and videotaping of some USWCA Events. The Rules Committee anticipates much discussion by USWCA event committees in the future. Any changes to allow either coaching or taping would be rules changes, so if changes were proposed by a committee, they would need approval by the organization. I anticipate each of the event committees to take up some discussion of this at the Fall Meetings.

A motion concerning substitutes for the USWCA National Bonspiel and the Senior Women's Bonspiel was presented at the Fall Meeting (September 19, 2010). This motion was tabled, and according to Parliamentary Rules, it has lapsed due to inactivity for a period of three months. The committee will take no further action on this motion at this time. The Rules Committee presented the National Women's Bonspiel Procedure Committee and the Sr. Women's Bonspiel Committee with official game record forms (timing and scoring forms) for use at their respective events.

Our discussion was lively - lots of views – just what it should be.

The committee could have spent more time discussing issues but the Executive Council Meeting awaited some of the participants of the meeting.
