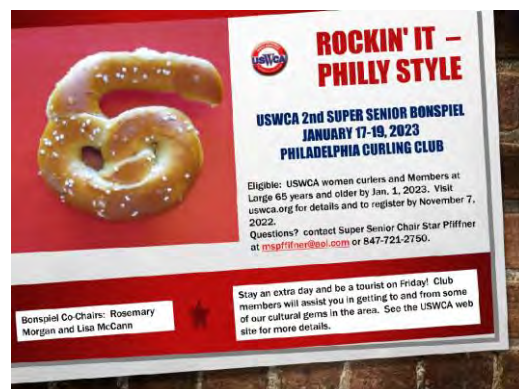

USWCA 2nd SUPER SENIOR WOMEN'S BONSPIEL

Philadelphia Curling Club is excited to welcome the 2nd Super Senior Bonspiel, "Rockin' It-Philly Style" to Paoli, Pennsylvania. The event will be held Tuesday, January 17 to Thursday, January 19, 2023 and 16 teams will participate in the 6-end bonspiel on 2 sheets of ice with a 3-game guarantee. Finals will be on Thursday – timing dependent upon number of teams. Philadelphia curlers have graciously offered to coordinate a sightseeing day of the area on Friday January 20 for those who are interested in staying longer. Eligible participants will be 65 or older by January 1, 2023 and have paid USWCA dues for the 2022-23 season. Members-at-Large are eligible to enter (USWCA dues paid by bonspiel deadline). Enter as an Individual and you will be placed on a team with curlers from other regions. or as a Composite Team - only two players from same club please. The other two players should be from a different region or club. Goal is to play with other curlers from different regions.
