ANOTHER CIRCUIT SEASON UNDERWAY

The USWCA Circuit supports women's bonspiels by attracting more teams to them and supports women curlers in the Spirit of Curling -- meeting other women curlers, involving newer curlers in the sport, improving skills through friendly competition and awarding cash prizes! The Circuit season runs from May 1 to April 30. All funds collected go back as prize money to the Circuit curlers (per Region). About 80% of participants receive prize money. Last year we awarded \$4,335 to Circuit participants.



Check the website for a full listing of the registered Circuit bonspiels, https://www.uswca.org/participating-bonspiels.aspx. We always welcome more bonspiels! If you have a ladies bonspiel that is not on the Circuit please consider registering it.

New curlers receive an extra 100 points their first year on the Circuit. This is a great opportunity to introduce newer curlers to competing outside of their clubs and making new friends from other clubs.

Remember to sign up for the Circuit before your first event (necessary for the bonspiel points to count). At least 2 members of the team must be registered with the Circuit for the bonspiel points to count.


LET'S HOST AN ALL-AMERICAN BONSPIEL!

Ask nearby USWCA member clubs to join your club. Last year as an example: St. Louis, Cedar Rapids and Waltham combined to compete in a one-day event at Waltham. Several clubs included some of their male members by making them Associate Members of the USWCA in order to have enough teams. These men (associate members) can also come from a nearby member club as well.

5 & UNDER BONSPIELS



This season the USWCA 5 and Under Committee is currently listing three bonspiels across the country for curlers with five years of experience or fewer. Two of our USWCA Five and Under Bonspiels are qualifiers for the USA Curling Five and Under Nationals.

East Region: Bucks County Curling Club, Warminster, PA (Open), January 18-20, 2024

Central Region: Charlotte Curling Association, Charlotte, NC (Modified Open), December 8-10, 2023 (USA National 5U Qualifier Event)

Wisconsin Region: Kettle Moraine Curling Club, Hartland, WI (Open), December 1-3 (USA National 5U Qualifier Event)

Note: There will be no Women's 5 & Under Bonspiels for the 2023-2024 Season. We will restart securing host sites for this event in all regions in 2024-2025. If any of our USWCA member clubs decide to include a 5U Women's event on their 2023-2024 calendar the USWCA 5U Bonspiel Committee will support the bonspiel with event pins and advertising.

JUNIOR BONSPIEL RESULTS

Two Junior Bonspiels were hosted last curling season since the last WRep Sheet issue was published.

The Four Seasons Club in Blaine, Minnesota held the West USWCA-sponsored Junior Bonspiel March 10-12, 2023. Todd Birr reported:

A total of 33 teams entered the event. There were 16 boys teams, 13 girls teams and 4 mixed teams. The Open Division winners were Team Berg from Bemidji, MN. Pins were awarded to four events and a plaque to the First Event winner.



The Cape Cod Curling Club in Falmouth, Massachusetts held the East USWCA-sponsored Junior Bonspiel July 23-26, 2023. Chair Matina Heisler reported:

On display at Cape Cod Curling Club's 2023 Junior Summerspiel was the future of curling. Some of the competitors were teams that played on the national and international stage. Some came out for their very first bonspiel. All of them had a great time.

The 2023 Junior Summerspiel was comprised of 11 teams from Maine

to California. Team Cenzalli took the win for their second consecutive year. Our other two events were won by Team Vidaurrazaga (Second Event) and Team Neill (Third Event).

The first event winners, Team Cenzalli, was skipped by Nicholas Cenzalli with Vice Shaheen Bassiri, Second Cayden Kraft, and Lead Dylan Ciapka.
