

ANOTHER CIRCUIT SEASON UNDERWAY

Our goal is to support women's bonspiels at our member clubs by attracting more teams to them and support women curlers in the Spirit of Curling -- meeting other women curlers, involving newer curlers in the sport, improving skills through friendly competition and awarding cash prizes! All funds collected go back as prize money to the Circuit Curlers, by region. A maximum of your top 3 bonspiels will count toward points. At least 2 people on the team must be registered with the Circuit for the points to count.

Charlotte Curling Association, Charlotte, NC (Open), December 6-8, 2024 (qualifier for USA Curling Five and Under Nationals)

Wisconsin Region:

Racine Curling Club, Racine (Women's) March 7-9, 2025 (qualifier for USA Curling Five and Under Nationals)

Madison Curling Club, Madison (Open), January 24-26, 2025 (qualifier for USA Curling Five and Under Nationals)

West Region:

Heather Curling Club, Mapleton, MN (Open) February 7-9, 2025 (qualifier for USA Curling Five and Under Nationals)

One Junior Bonspiel was hosted last curling season since the last WRep Sheet issue was published.

The Denver Curling Club in Golden, Colorado held the West USWCA-sponsored Junior Bonspiel May 10-12, 2024. The winning team was Team Treynor: Karina Treyor and Alexis Kong from San Francisco and Alice Mihm and Violet Bartels from Minnesota.

Twenty-four curlers participated from the Denver CC, Rock Creek CC, San Francisco Bay Area Curling Club and St. Paul Curling Club.



GIFTS AND GRANTS

The Gifts and Grants Committee financially supports curling by women and youth, including Junior Travel Assistance. Thank you to all who helped increase the funding for this year. At the Fall Meeting 2024 in Milwaukee, the Board of Directors approved four requests presented by the Gifts and Grants Committee. This season's grants were awarded to:

- Team Wilson- St. Paul/Four Seasons (4/4 eligible USWCA) \$300
- Junior Team Charles Madison, Portage, Lodi, Kettle Morraine (3/4 eligible USWCA) - \$275
- Mayfield Tyler George Event assistance \$425
- Jersey Pinelands Curling Club Assistance with Arena Ice Costs for All American – \$320

Club representatives please help drive applications for Gifts and Grants for your clubs. It can be for travel for juniors and women, but also for coaching, helping your club be ADA compliant, events that help a broader group, and so on. USWCA has a special interest in 5 and Under Women's teams attempting to qualify, or who have qualified for Nationals so please look for those teams in your club and encourage them to apply for grants.

Applications are reviewed twice per year during the Fall and the Winter meetings. The deadline for consideration at the Winter 2025 Meeting is 2 weeks prior the Meeting, March 1, 2025. Applicants will be notified of their grant application status following each meeting. Funds will be released when receipts and pictures are received. Applications can be submitted with receipts for an event that has already taken place.
