USWCA Fall 2025 Board of Directors Meeting
Club Representatives, Committee Chairs, and Officers are voting members of the USWCA and must be present in person for the organization to meet quorum and for the meeting to be viable. For Club Representatives not able to attend in person who do not appoint an alternate, you may assign a proxy to a Committee Chair attending in person, another Representative attending in person, or the USWCA Secretary. The proxies do not count toward quorum. Note: For Committee Chairs who are unable to attend meetings in person, an Acting Chair must be designated and communicated to the President and Secretary prior to the meetings. The Acting Chair will assume the voting privileges of the Chair. If the Committee Chair is also a Club Representative, she is entitled to one additional vote and may assign this additional vote via proxy.
On Saturday, September 13 th , the day before the Board of Directors (BoD) Meeting, the USWCA Secretary will provide a Zoom link for anyone unable to attend in person. Those attending via Zoom are considered full participants in the meeting and your attendance will count toward the quorum. Your hand raised will be your vote. The BoD will begin at 8:00AM (EST), but you should consider logging into the meeting just after 7:30AM to avoid delaying the count of a quorum.
If you need to leave the BoD Meeting early, you will need to designate someone in the room before you leave the meeting. This is usually the USWCA Secretary.
In order to be a full participant, your screen will need to be turned on just as though you are sitting in the room.
