Surrounded by forested hill-sides that reach down toward the valleys which are separated by various Wisconsin Driftless Area trout streams. There is an abundance of wildlife and wildflowers that thrive in this area with the forests, prairie remnants, wetlands, and grasslands. Amish were the first to adopt this area and still farm the land today alongside a multitude of organic farmers. How Did the Wisconsin Driftless Area Get Its Name?

This area's name is derived from the fact that it was surrounded by glaciers during the last glacial period, yet remained untouched by passing glaciers. This caused some curious, and beautiful, topography in these areas drawing visitors year-round. In accordance with its name, the Driftless Zone in Wisconsin is also a mark to the furthestmost edge of the glaciers' advance.
