Experience "A Buckeye Murder Mystery" at the 39th Senior Women's Bonspiel, hosted by the Columbus Curling Club on November 11-15, 2020. This is your first notice from the Senior Women's Bonspiel Procedure Committee announcing this event that will consist of 24 teams on 3 sheets of ice. This notice is going out during the current curling season (2019-2020) so that you can be aware of the date and plan to attend. The final invitation and intent form will be sent out in August of 2020, to all USWCA club representatives, liaisons, past skips and singles.

Please inform your women curlers of this event and its date via your club communications network so they can begin organizing their teams and making travel plans. Multiple team entries from the same club are encouraged. Entries may be sent in at any time. Checks will not be cashed until teams are chosen.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

1. Entrants must have reached 55 years of age before January 1, 2021. A team entering the bonspiel must be composed of four women members of the USWCA in good standing and with regular curling privileges at a USWCA member club or facility. They must have curled in at least one league at their registered club.
2. Play downs are not allowed. Teams are assigned a number in the order they are initially drawn. Allocation figures are determined by total membership of participating clubs submitting entries in their specific geographic region.
3. Each team must have at least three curling members from one club. Another member from the same geographic region may make up a composite team.
4. Multiple team entries from one club and composite entries have equal standing in that region draw.
5. For this Bonspiel, a composite team's name shall be at the discretion of the skip and her team, and shall so be listed. However, each member's club shall be noted.
6. A single member entry is appropriate and, indeed URGED, and will be used to fill out teams as needed, both before and at the event. (No entry fee required.)
7. Please retain your team structure as long as possible if you are not drawn. Stand-by teams are often needed, as are single entry members.
8. Entries may be sent in now and the total entry fee will be **\$400**. The **Total Fee** and **Team Entry** will be due on September 11, 2020. **Deadline strictly enforced.** Send all complete entries and check payable to **Columbus Curling Club** to:
