

Racine Curling Club Racine, WI November 30th - December 4th, 2022

The 40th Senior Women's Bonspiel will be held at the **Racine Curling Club Nov 30th thru Dec 4th** as a 16 team event on two sheets of ice. The Senior Women's Bonspiel Procedure Committee requests you share this notice and entry form with all eligible women at your club before your 2021-2022 curling season ends. Entry forms may be submitted any time from now but must be received by the **Sept 2, 2022** deadline date. Multiple entry forms from the same club are allowed. Only the checks from the teams that are selected randomly will be processed after the Sept 2nd deadline. The bonspiel theme is "**Diamonds and Denim**", and the on-site bonspiel chair is Gail Armstrong.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. All team members listed on the entry form must be 55 or more years of age before Jan 1st 2023, and must be a USWCA member in good standing with regular curling privileges at a USWCA member club. All team members are required to have curled in a league during the 2021-2022 season.
- 2. Play downs for team rankings within a club are not allowed. All teams will be ranked by the SWBP Committee chair based on the order the teams have been randomly drawn. Allocation of selected teams will be assigned for each region based on total membership of participating clubs and the number of entry forms submitted from their region.
- 3. Each team must have at least 3 members from the same club, and may include a 4th team member from a different club in the same USWCA region, making them a composite team.
- 4. Composite teams will have equal standings in the random draw as that for teams with all 4 members curling from the same club.
- 5. Composite team entry forms must indicate the club where each member curls.
- 6. Entry forms from single curlers is recommended. These individuals will be used to complete the selected teams that need to replace a curler as the bonspiel approaches. No rink fee payment is required with single entry forms.
- 7. Please keep your team intact even if you are *not* selected in the initial random draw. These team members, as well as individual entry forms, will be placed on a standby list should a team drop out or is short one curler.
- 8. All completed entry forms will be submitted with a check for \$400 made payable to Racine Curling Club. Entry forms and fees must be received by Wendy Berger, SWBPC Chair, 419 Greenhill Ct, Albany, NY 12203 by Sept. 2nd, 2022. This event has been oversubscribed the past several years so the deadline will be strictly enforced.
