It is with great pleasure that we welcome you to the Pacific Northwest for the 2020 USWCA Winter Meeting in Seattle, Washington. The dates are Monday, February 17 to Wednesday, February 19. Note: The Survey can be easily accessed via your preferred device, even on smartphones, and should take 10 minutes or less to complete.



## Hotel:

The **Hotel Nexus** will be our headquarters for the meeting. Rooms have been reserved at a rate of \$119+tax per night for double occupancy (one King or Double Queen). Our negotiated rate will be honored 3 days before and after the meeting dates for a limited number of rooms for those who wish to extend their stay.

We encourage you to take a rideshare service from Sea-Tac Airport to the hotel. See transportation information on the website.

## Meetings:

**On-site Registration desk** will be open at 11:00 am Monday, February 17.

- **The Scot Tour Committee** will have a special meeting on Monday morning from 8:00 am -10:00 am to complete their extended agenda. This is their only meeting. Committee members should plan to arrive the day before, Sunday.
- **The Governance Committee** will meet Monday morning from 10:00 am-12 noon. This is their only meeting. Committee members should plan to arrive the day before.
- **Executive Meetings** (Officers and Committee Chairs) begin at 12 noon on Monday.
- **Committee meetings** begin at 3:00 pm (opposite some Executive Meetings) and continue until 5:25 pm. On Tuesday, committee meetings go from 7:30 am – 5:25 pm.
- **Executive Council** (officers and Committee Chairs) will meet on Tuesday at 2:30 pm.
- The **Representatives** meeting will begin Tuesday at 4:00 pm.
- Wednesday, the **Board of Directors** (all voting Representatives and officers) meet from 8:30 am-12:30 pm. Attendance sign-in at 8:15 am.

- The **Hospitality Room** will be open for early arrivals on Sunday, February 16 from 5:00 pm-6:30 pm, on Monday and Tuesday evenings after dinner (hours TBD), and evenings during the Bonspiel (hours TBD).

## Activities:

Planned activities during the meetings are the following:

- On Monday evening, the **President's Dinner** will be held at a nearby Brewery. Sign up for transportation at the registration desk. (\$10)
- Tuesday, 12 noon-1:30 pm there are several **Dutch Treat Lunch** options. The hotel shuttle service will provide transportation to several restaurants south of the Regal Movie complex, rides on a first-come-first-served basis (10 passengers per ride). We suggest you choose from local options: Kizuki Ramen & Izakaya, Tengu Sushi, Watershed Pub. Others restaurants, walking distance from the curling club: HK Dim Sum, serving dim sum all day long, Pop Pop Thai Street Food, in the same shopping center. (Check with the front desk whether the shuttle is available.)  
Recommended restaurants (need a car): Geo's Cuban Bar & Grill, Greenwood at 105<sup>th</sup>; Indo Café, 137<sup>th</sup> and Aurora; El Camion North, local food truck at 117<sup>th</sup> and Aurora.
- Those who have lunch meetings Tuesday may order Box lunches. (\$20)
- Tuesday evening, (no-host) **Cocktails and Dinner** will be served in the Ballroom of the Hotel Nexus, our host hotel. Purchase drink tickets with cash only, then use tickets to order drinks. Non-alcoholic beverages will be complimentary. An ATM is located in the hotel lobby. Dinner is a Mediterranean Gyro Bar. (\$25)
- Following the Board of Directors Meeting on Wednesday, an **Indian cuisine lunch** will be served family style at tables for four at the Saffron Restaurant, located across the parking lot from the hotel. (\$22)
