INAUGURAL SUPER SENIOR BONSPIEL

The USWCA is proud to offer a new 2-day event for USWCA women 65 years of age and older. The inaugural Super Senior Bonspiel will be held January 11-12, 2022, at the Blackhawk Curling Club in Janesville, WI, one hour from the Chicago airports. Eligible participants will be 65 or older by January 1, 2022; Games will be 6-ends with a 3-game guarantee. The entry fee is \$60 and the entry deadline is November 4th.

The purpose of the event is to mix with women curlers from other regions so sign up as an individual and you will be placed on a team. Members-at-Large are also welcome. You can also sign up as a composite team with women from other regions; only one person per club is allowed on a team.

USWCA CIRCUIT BEGINS SECOND DECADE

WHAT: The Circuit is an "umbrella' for USWCA women curlers to support women's bonspiels at USWCA Clubs, and earn points based on participation, team makeup and games won. Bonus points are awarded for new curlers and juniors. An individual's top three bonspiels count. Pay a fee (\$30) and have at least one other Circuit participant on your team to earn points. At season end, the top 50%+ in each region will receive cash prizes. Can you believe it? This is a tough transition year, but we can each do our part and help our beloved sport. Our goal is to promote and grow women's curling across the country.

BENEFITS: Support women's curling! More curling leads to improved curling, new friends and you'll be supporting the growth and development of women curlers, not to mention all of the fun at bonspiels. More curlers, fuller bonspiels? It's a WIN/WIN!

SHOULD MY CLUB JOIN? Yes! If you have a women's bonspiel, sign it up! Many women focus on Circuit events to support their "sister curlers" and perhaps win some cash too! A number of women's bonspiels have seen increased participation as a result of joining the Circuit. The fee is \$100 to register your Bonspiel. This season the USWCA 5 and Under Committee is currently listing seven bonspiels across the country for curlers with five years of experience or fewer.

NOTE: Due to the blank end policy adopted in September of 2020, the year 2020/2021 does not count towards eligibility for Five and Under Bonspiels.

Please note: some host clubs may require proof of Covid vaccinations to participate in their bonspiels. Non-vaccinated curlers submitting applications will need to check with the host club on this requirement.

JUNIOR BONSPIELS

The USWCA sponsors three Junior bonspiels per season in the East (GNCC), Central (OH, IL, IN, MI, MO, TN, WI), and West (AK, AZ, CA, CO, MN, ND, NE, OR, WA) territories. The USWCA provides host clubs with winner and runner up pins for four events, as well as a trophy for the first event winners. Travel assistance is available for teams that travel 150 miles or more by car or 300 miles or more by bus, rail or air. This season's bonspiels will be held at:

CENTRAL: February 11 - 13, 2022, Rice Lake CC, Rice Lake, Wisconsin
