Nominating a Candidate for 2nd Vice President

Any member of the USWCA may submit names of qualified candidates to the nominating committee for consideration. To make a nomination, complete the "USWCA 2nd VP Nomination Form," available on the uswca.org website and follow further instructions. Nominations can also be made from the floor at the Winter Board of Directors Meeting. A prospective candidate will need to complete the "USWCA 2nd VP Candidate Form" and provide it both to the Nominating Committee and to her Proposer. Attributes of a USWCA Officer

- Must be an American Citizen.
- Exhibits administrative and leadership qualities.
- Demonstrates a working knowledge of the USWCA.
- Shows dedication to the sport of curling.
- Is committed to 4 years of leadership work with the USWCA.
- Models respect toward and inclusiveness of others.

Officer Responsibilities (summarized from Bylaws):

2nd VP

1. Serves on and oversees committees related to events and tours: Five & Under, Junior Bonspiel, Senior Bonspiel, National Bonspiel, All-American, Circuit, Friendship Tour (In/Out), Scot Tour (In/Out), Pins and Trophies
2. Corresponds concerning future sites of the USWCA National and Senior Women's Bonspiels.
3. Serves on Governance Committee.

1st VP

1. Educates and trains the Representatives
2. Arranges and chairs Representatives meeting
3. Chairs Representatives' Liaison Committee and supervises Liaisons
4. Serves on Communications and Governance Committees
5. Oversees Membership Committee

President

1. Supervises all USWCA business and affairs, as principal executive officer.
2. Presides at meetings of Executive Council, Board of Directors. Prepares agenda for these meetings.
3. Appoints Chairs of Standing Committees and their membership, except for the USWCA/USCA Liaison and Nominating Committee Chair.
4. Acts a spokesperson for the USWCA.
5. Oversees Communications Committee and serves on Governance Committee.
